Follow the A55 across Anglesey to Holyhead. On entering Holyhead, follow the signs for the Port. At the roundabout near the entrance to the Port, turn right and then immediately left onto Turkey Shore Road. Follow this road for about a quarter of a mile then turn right into Ffordd Tudur (4<sup>th</sup> turning on the right). Follow this road and take the first turning left into the Gwelfor Car Park.



**Parking** 

There is parking available at the Community Centre with some disabled spaces just outside the entrance.

You can get the bus from Victoria Road, it's serviced by 24A which stops just outside the Community Centre. It should take around 5 minutes.



The closest train station is Holyhead which is a 15 minute walk to the Community Centre.


Exit the station and walk towards London Road.

Turn left and walk along London Road, turn left again onto the A55 opposite Lidl. Continue down the A55 until you get to a roundabout.

Turn right next to The Edinburgh Castle and cross onto Turkey Shore Road, follow this road all the way along and turn right down Ffordd Tudor. Go down this road and the Community Centre is on your left.
